Our Inspections:

Standard Inspection

1. Health Department records are reviewed.
2. The tanks lids or observation ports are located by probing or other means and opened for inspection
3. The septic tank is inspected for construction, leaks, decay and proper baffle tees.
4. A sludge measurement is performed to evaluate the state of the septic tank. This measurement is used to determine if the tank requires maintenance
5. A hydraulic flow test is performed and the tanks operating level is observed for changes
6. Pump function and alarms are tested if present.
7. Secondary treatment unit is inspected if present.
8. The dispersal area is probed and evaluated from the surface for evidence of pooling, ponding or anaerobic conditions

Comprehensive Inspection

Recommended for alternative onsite sewage systems, older conventional systems & unoccupied properties with signs of concerns

1. All items in standard inspection are included.
2. Pump drawdown times and pump amperage are checked
3. Distribution boxes are uncovered and evaluated.
4. Pressurized dispersal systems are evaluated.
5. Sewer line, conveyance lines and conventional drain field lines are inspected with a sewer camera or other means of evaluation
6. Tank may require pumping for further evaluation
